





Formal uniform is required on:

Formal uniform days are noted on

the website calendar

Informal uniforms are to be worn on other days

#### **Uniform Guidelines**

#### Traditional Learning Centre



All uniform pieces should be clearly and permanently labelled so that in the event that a piece is found, it may be returned to the correct student.



There are a number of casual days where students are not required to wear uniform. These are noted on the website calendar.

Before volunteering, all volunteers must:

Step 1: Obtain a registration form from the office

We strongly recommend that if there is any chance that you could volunteer during your child's time at Brentwood School that you complete this process as soon as you can. One government issued photo ID will be required to start the process.

Step 2: Obtain Police Security Clearance (ePIC)

This process can take between 2-5 weeks. This document is valid for 5 years and can transfer between CBE schools.

We currently have 13 bus routes that serve our designated TLC area in NW Calgary.

The largest communities that our school serves are: Sherwood, Nolan Hill, Royal Oak, and Tuscany. Bus routes reflect this.

Brentwood provides direct supervision as busses arrive in the morning, and enhanced supervision in the afternoon as busses depart. On the first few days of school, all teachers are outside helping students find the right bus home.

\*You must register by the deadline to ensure yellow school bus service for the first day of classes in September. This is done through MyCBE PowerSchool. There is no financial obligation for registration; families have until the fall to cancel without a fee.
